I. Lectures:

- 1. Characteristic of contemporary forestry enterprises in Bulgaria Company and enterprise as a form of realizing of management activity and their special features in the field of forestry. Changes in law's and normative order in the field of forestry. Regime of work.
- 2. Production process and organization forms of production in the field of forestry Essence, structure, characteristic, main principles and organizational forms of production.
- 3. Organization of uses of assets in forestry enterprises Organization of uses of current and fixed assets, forest areas and forest stands.
- 4. Organization of labor in forestry enterprises Essence and tasks of organization of labor. Team organization of labor. Organization of work places.
- 5. Standardization of labor in forest enterprises Practical standardization. Methods for standardization of labor. Classification of expenditures of working time and methods for their investigation. Determination and rectification of labor standards.
- 6. Organization of wages in forestry enterprises Main principles and characteristic of organization of wages. Determination of individual wages and specific characteristic.
- 7. Basis of planning and analysis in forestry enterprises Essence, principles, methods and organization of planning and analysis. Prognosis and long-term planning. Type of plans.
- 8. Planning and analysis of forestry activities.
- 9. Planning and analysis of logging activities.
- 10.Business planning.
